You are encouraged to read the book selection for the month but you can always join us and listen to what others have to say. It may perk your interest and you'll read the book.

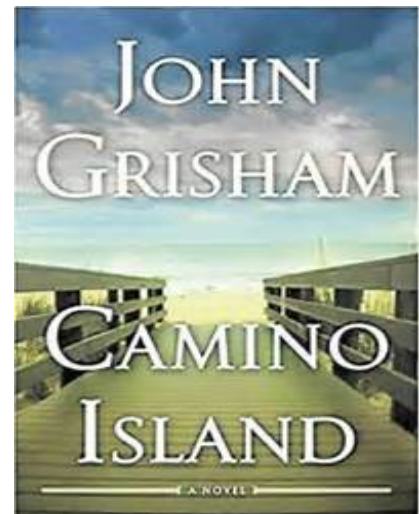
## Book Club Meeting December 6th at 6pm
