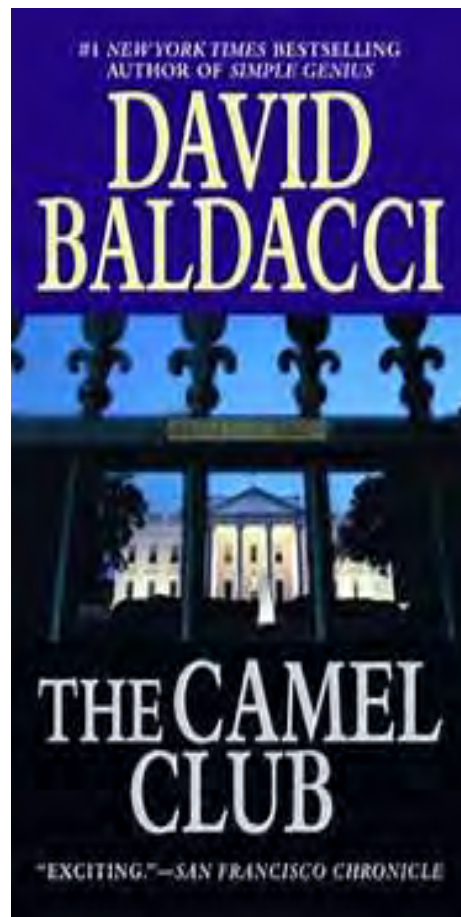

NOTICE OF RACE



1. RULES 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing(RSS), Class Rules for boats competing with Class OD ratings, PHRF-SS, CYRA, this NOR and the Regatta SI's 1.2 The following prescriptions of the US Sailing will not apply: 60 and 63.4. 1.3 RRS 63.7 is replaced by "If there is a conflict between The Notice Of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply." 1.4 The Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.
2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY 2.1 The regatta is open to all members of a National Sailing Authority, ILYA Yacht Club or One Design Class Association 2.2 Possession of a current, valid rating certificate or one design class membership is required. PHRF Certificates will be accepted from any PHRF organization. The measurement information from that certificate will be used to calculate the rating for your boat using the PHRF-SS rules (<http://www.phrf-ss.org/>). The calculated rating may in some instances not match the rating listed on your certificate. 2.3 Registration will be available online at: www.RegattaNetwork.com
3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 3.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on Thursday, July 12, 2018
4. FEES 4.1 Regatta (PHRF & JAM) \$80.00 4.2 Women's & Double-Handed Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker (Friday Night) \$30.00 4.3 GULDEN McCARTY (Sunday ONLY) \$40.00
5. VENUE 5.1 Racing will take place on the waters of Lake Erie, North of Lakeside Yacht Club.
6. SCORING 6.1 The scoring system will be In accordance with the RRS Appendix A and may be modified by the Sailing Instructions, Class Rules or Class Regatta Regulations. 6.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
7. GUEST DOCKAGE AND LAUNCHING 7.1 Complimentary dockage will be provided from Wednesday, July 11, 2018, through Monday, July 16, 2018. There will be PHRF racing Wednesday evening. 8. PRIZES 8.1 1st, 2nd and 3rd awards in each class and the Jon R. Ruhlman Trophy for Overall.
9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY 9.1 Per RRS 4: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
10. PARKING 10.1 Parking space is at a premium. Non- members' cars are not allowed to park in the club lot, but parking is provided at Sailing Inc. Lakeside will provide a complimentary shuttle.

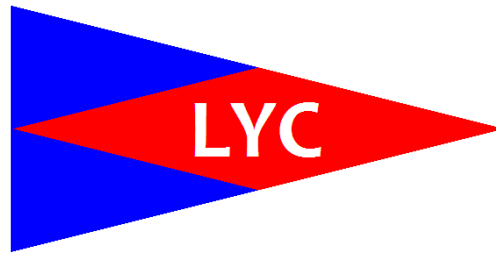

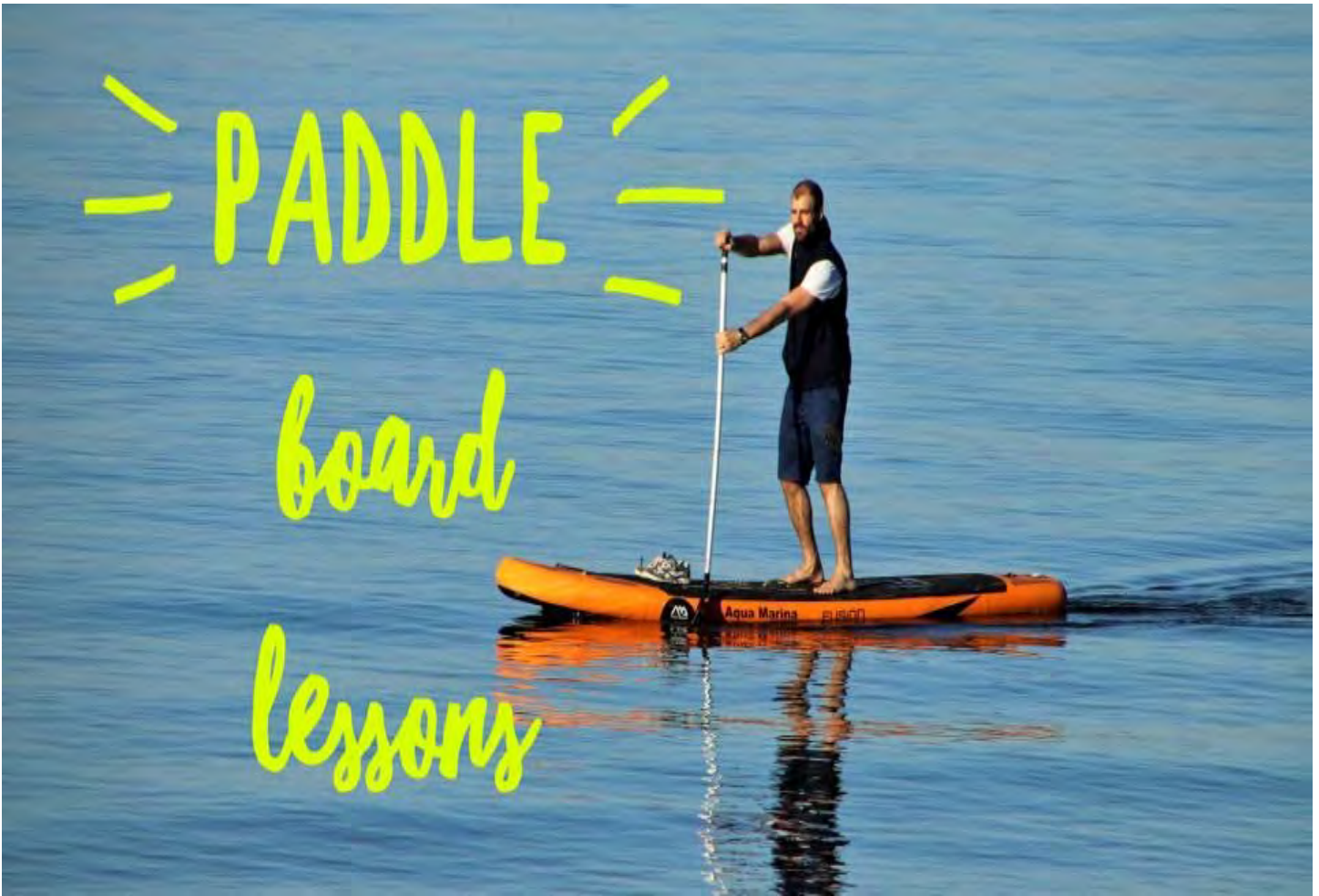

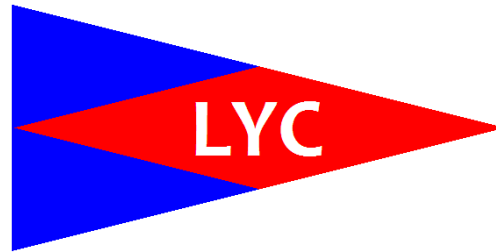
