"Before We Were Yours"

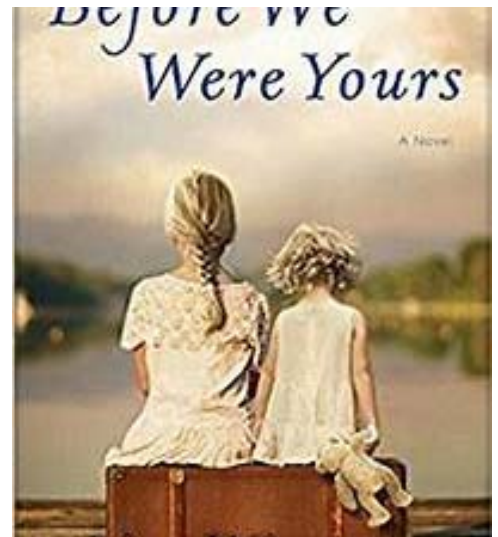
